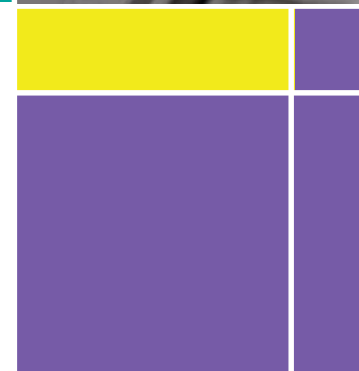
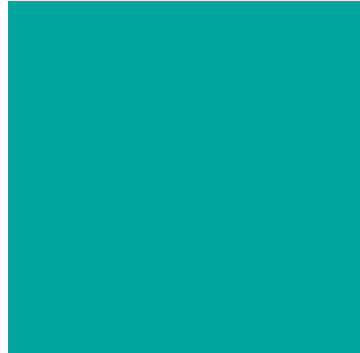

In addition to the mining and pharmaceutical sectors, our clients include construction materials, petroleum, chemical, automotive, manufacturing, energy, as well as contracts with independent consultants and the public sector. Bureau Veritas has been the contract laboratory for the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) since 2006, keeping us at the forefront of sampling and analytical issues.

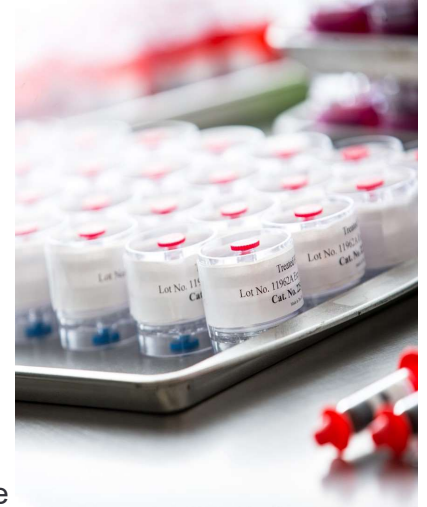
